Executive Sessions

The Board may meet in executive session to discuss subjects allowed by statute but may not take final action.

Executive sessions may be held during regular, special or emergency meetings for any reason permitted by law. The list of most applicable reasons for executive sessions are referenced in the Bylaws and can be found at

http://www.doj.state.or.us/pdf/public_records_and_meetings_manual.pdf.

The presiding officer will announce the executive session by identifying the authorization under ORS 192.660 for holding such session and by noting the subject of the executive session. Representatives of the news media (as defined at Board Policy BDC-AR) may attend executive sessions except those matters pertaining to: deliberations with persons designated by the Board to carry on labor negotiations; and current litigation or litigation likely to be filed if the member of the news media is a party to the litigation or is an employee, agent or contractor of a news media organization that is a party to the litigation.

An executive session may be convened by the Board Chair upon request of 50% of the Board members or by common consent of the Board for a purpose authorized under ORS 192.660.

All executive session minutes shall be kept in written form and shall be maintained in a confidential file accessible only to the board and the board designees.

Content discussed in executive sessions is confidential.
