Parents will be notified by phone or email on February 1, 2017 if the student is offered a seat or on the waiting list. When a student is offered a seat, parents have 24 hours to confirm acceptance by phone or email. Failure to confirm acceptance within 24 hours shall be deemed a decision by parents to not enroll the student for the 2017-18 school year, and the school will contact the first student on the waiting list.

### 1st - 8th GRADES

Applications for 1st through 8th grades are due March 3, 2017. The lottery for 1st through 8th grade admission is a public meeting at the school on March 7, 2017 at 6:00pm. A parent who has submitted a complete application is not required to be present for a student to be selected. Parents will be notified by phone or email on February 4, 2017 if the student is offered a seat or on the waiting list. When a student is offered a seat, parents have 24 hours to confirm acceptance by phone or email. Failure to confirm acceptance within 24 hours shall be deemed a decision by parents to not enroll the student for the 2017-18 school year, and the school will contact the first student on the waiting list.
